MINUTES: The minutes of the previous meeting were read by the Secretary, and confirmed on the motion of W.O. Morgan and Mr. Macindoe.

CORRESPONDENCE: Was read by the Secretary, and duly received.

SECRETARY'S REPORT: The Secretary gave a brief report of the activities of the Association.

TREASURER'S REPORT: The Treasurer reported on the financial position of the General Account and the Welfare Account.

SOCIAL SUB-COMMITTEE: The Treasurer reported on the progress of arrangements for the First Re-Union, to be held on 2nd November, 1945. By general assent, the final arrangements were left in the hands of the Social Sub-Committee.

WELFARE: The President, reported the gift of £250 from the the 3rd Light Anti-Aircraft Regiment Welfare Association, and on the motion of Mr. Hilliard, seconded by Lt. Rosenberg, the following motion of appreciation was recorded.

"This Association records its appreciation of the services rendered by all members of the 3rd Light Anti-Aircraft Regimental Welfare Association, and thankfully acknowledges their gift of £250 to our Welfare Fund."

The President brought forward the matter of more frequent General Meetings. This was discussed, and it was agreed that members of the Committee, report at the next meeting their views on the matter, after testing the feelings of members of the Association at the First Re-Union on 2nd November.

It was resolved that the next Committee Meeting be held on Thursday, 8th November, at a place to be notified.
