MINUTES OF GENERAL COMMITTEE MEETING

PRESENT: The President, Mr. A.G. Margetts in the chair, and Messrs. Bishop, Hilliard, Roberts, Rosenberg and Haines.

APOLOGIES: Were received from Messrs. Hopkins, Humphreys, Macindoe, Jorgensen, Swift and Wiley.

VISITOR: The President welcomed Mr. W. E. Kerr as a visitor.

MINUTES: The Minutes of the previous General Meeting were read by the Secretary and confirmed on the motion of Messrs. Bishop and Hilliard.

TREASURER'S REPORT: The Treasurer's report was received on the motion of Messrs. Roberts and Rosenberg.
The report showed Credit Balances of £110. 8.11 in the General A/C, and £49.10. 4 in the Welfare Account, and a Deposit of £300 in Commonwealth Security Bonds.

SECRETARY'S REPORT: The Secretary reported on arrangements made to date in respect of re-union to be held on 24th April, 1947. The report was received on the motion of Messrs. Hilliard & Roberts.

GENERAL: A General discussion took place on the details of arrangements for the forthcoming re-union. It was resolved that a Sub-committee consisting of C.S. Rosenberg, W.E. Kerr, W.T. Hopkins and J. Watson act as door keepers for the collection of entrance money and subscriptions, this Sub-committee having power to co-opt other members.

It was also resolved that the matter of catering and engaging stewards be left in the hands of Mr. G. Roberts.

On the motion of Messrs. Bishop and Hilliard, it was agreed that the Sub-committee elected on 5th December, 1946 have power to assess the admittance charge to the re-union, such charge not to exceed the sum of 7/6d. per head.
