### COMMITTEE'S REPORT FOR 15th MONTHS ENDING 30th JUNE, 1948

At the 2nd Annual General Meeting held at the Returned Soldiers' Hall, Holmes Road, Moonee Ponds on the 24th April, 1947 there was an attendance of approximately 200 members and the following Office Bearers were elected.

This Committee met regularly each month during the period, and sub-Committees were formed to report to the General Committee on the various activities of the Association.

Financial assistance was given on two occasions during the year and several food parcels were sent to Britain.

During the fifteen months five "Bulletins" have been forwarded to all ex-members of the Regiment whose addresses were available. The "Bulletins" comprised personal news and whereabouts of members, and according to reports they were all well received.

A Cabaret Ball was held at the "Rainbow Hall", Prahran on the 24th September, 1947. Although the Ball was not a financial success all members who attended thoroughly enjoyed themselves.

The Annual Reunion was held on Friday evening, the 23rd April, 1948 in the Artillery Hall, Batman Avenue, Melbourne. 302 members attended, which augurs well for the future.

The General Account with the Commercial Banking Company of Sydney Limited shows a credit balance of £170. 8. 3.

The Welfare Account with the Commonwealth Bank of Australia shows a credit balance of £51.16.1. £300 from the Welfare Account is invested in Commonwealth Government Bonds.

The accompanying Statement of Receipts and Disbursements sets out clearly the way our funds have been received and expended.

During the past fifteen months it has been noticeable that more members are appreciating the link with the past which the Association maintains, and the Annual Re-unions for 1949 should see even a greater attendance than that for 1948.
